FAQ

What is the first step in joining the Consortium RN-BSN Completion Program (Consortium)?

• It is helpful to meet and speak with Sylvia Mayer <u>smayer@southern.edu</u>. Make an appointment & bring copies of your college transcripts – if possible. This will help you know what college classes you will need to take.

How do I apply to the Consortium?

- First, apply to Southern Adventist University https://www.southern.edu/undergrad/ (Major = BSN (RN-BSN Consortium))
 - Second, apply to the **School of Nursing** ... apply online and ☑ RN-BSN Consortium https://www.southern.edu/academics/nursing/
- You need to make a SAU email account and have your SAU picture ID card made when you are accepted.

Will I have an advisor?

• Sylvia Mayer is your advisor for both BSN Completion and for the BSN part of your RN-MSN program. It works best to email Sylvia. Together you can work out a time to call or do a face2face or Zoom meeting. She also visits the Consortium classes regularly to answer questions and get to know you better.

Can I get financial aid?

• Most likely! You will need to see a student financial counselor. Go to www.southern.edu and click on "Future Student", then choose Finance. Remember, most hospitals provide an educational benefit, so be sure and check that out. Loans generally require that you take 6 credits, but work out the details with your student financial counselor. You can contact them at 423-236-2535 or studentfinance@southern.edu.

Are there clinical courses?

Pop/Comm Health, Leadership & Management, and Health Assessment have some clinical or practical experience hours. You may need to take one designated day off. For other hours, we make effort to work with you to schedule clinical hours around your schedule, as much as possible. Of course, sometimes you will need to adjust your schedule as well.

How do I register?

■ Your advisor may have to register you the first time. After that, you will be "coded" as a Consortium student and should be able to register yourself for Consortium classes. If you receive an "error" message, just forward the email to your advisor, Sylvia Mayer, with your ID#, and she will see what needs to be done. If you receive notice of a "HOLD", you will need to clear the "HOLD" prior to registering.

Books?

• When you register, you will find a list of your classes and a booklist on "My Access" ... your southern.edu site. Textbooks are available for purchase online via the **Campus Shop**, or you may purchase from any book seller. See the SAU calendar for book buy-back and beginning of book sale dates.

Anything else?

■ You will need to keep up-to-date with clinical requirements such as your nursing license, TB clearance, CPR, HIPAA, and complete a background check. It is essential that you check your Southern email daily. It is helpful to include your ID# in all emails.

Rules of Thumb – 3 semesters / year

Summer Semester

- Check for the start date each year...usually a week after graduation
- Classes meet every Monday 2pm 8:30pm ... usually 2-5 pm & 5:30 8:30 pm
- Classes meet May, June, July and sometime extends into the beginning of August
- No classes on Memorial Day or 4th of July (if it falls on a Monday)

No classes for a couple weeks in August...a great time to take your vacation!

Fall Semester

- Classes start in August, the same day that SAU Campus classes begin
- No classes on Labor Day or week of Thanksgiving Break

Winter Semester

- Classes start in January, the same day that SAU Campus classes begin
- No classes on MLK Day or week of Spring Break
