## The success of your LifeGroup is often dependent on one major thing: your overflow.


### What is overflow?

#### Corporate Worship:

- Where do you find belonging in faith community?
- Do you have a church you actively engage in?

#### Outreach/Service:

• How are you fulfilling the gospel mandate of James 1:26 and Micah 6:8?

#### Life Calling:

 How are you aligning your future with God's vision for your life?





#### Step into Scripture.

Choose a character in the story.

- 1) The paralyzed man,
- 2) One of his friends,
  - 3) A disciple,
- 4) An ill person in the crowd who was not healed.

## How does God's Word apply to your life?

#### While stepping into scripture ask:

- What do you observe as you put yourself in the shoes of your character?
- How does this story intersect with your life?
- What is Jesus' invitation to you?

Share your reflections with your group.






## We want to ensure you belong, behold, and become first.

  - Make weekly events for your LifeGroup via the website.
  - Once you have weekly events set up, you'll be able to click "take attendance" on the day of the event.
  - Take attendance and click submit.
- To make changes to your events, members, etc. you must visit groups.planningcenteronline.com or email lifegroups@southern.edu.
- Keep membership up-to-date.
  - o Remove members who are inactive.
  - Check for new member requests.
