# F. PROJECT PROPOSAL -Priscille Mikala & Allen Gustrowsky

- a. Pickleball Project Proposal
  - i. Pickleball has become very popular on campus
  - ii. There are very few places where they can play
  - iii. Why this proposal?
    - 1. Meet the growing interest in pickleball
    - 2. May be donors interested in helping create pickleball courts
    - 3. Ensure demand for pickleball courts is met in the near future since the SA Contingency fund is largely allocated to Futsal Courts
      - a. Not competing with futsal project
  - iv. This plan will depend on availability of donations
  - v. Tentative Plan
    - 1. Phase 1 Planning
      - a. Gather a team
      - b. Gauge student interest by creating a poll and use those results in donor pitches
      - c. Set clear goals: fundraising targets and costs
      - d. Secure approval from Southern Administration
    - 2. Phase 2 Fundraising
      - a. Develop Proposal & Communicate with donors
        - i. Include donor benefits
        - ii. Personalized emails and meet with the donors to keep them updated
      - b. Leverage Social Media
        - i. Be transparent / raise awareness among students and alumni of Southern
        - ii. Channels of communication: *Southern Accent*, Instagram, Facebook
    - 3. Phase 3 Finalizing Details
      - a. Formalize donor agreement with clear terms
      - b. Secure donor commitments
      - c. Set deadlines for pledges to make sure sufficient funding is

#### available before construction starts

- 4. Phase 4 Breaking Ground (most tentative)
  - a. Hand off to Southern
  - b. Still working on details of this phase
